1. Purpose

This policy explains our approach to collecting, managing, and protecting authentic customer reviews while helping prevent review manipulation and brand impersonation.

2. Scope

This policy applies to all reviews relating to Audacity Capital, regardless of whether they appear on:

- Official Audacity Capital websites
- Third-party review platforms
- Social media platforms
- Public forums
- Any other publicly accessible channel

3. What We Consider a Fake Review

A fake review includes, but is not limited to:

- Reviews submitted by individuals who have never used our services
- Fabricated or misleading trading experiences
- Reviews intended to manipulate public opinion or ratings
- Reviews published under false identities
- AI-generated or automated reviews that do not represent genuine customer experiences
- Reviews published on behalf of another individual without permission

4. Our Commitment

We do not:

- Purchase fake reviews
- Pay for positive reviews
- Offer incentives, discounts, or rewards for positive feedback
- Ask customers to edit or remove genuine negative reviews
- Publish reviews on behalf of customers

- Manipulate review ratings or scores

5. Customer Reviews

Customers may be invited to provide feedback after using our services. They are encouraged to share:

- Positive experiences
- Constructive criticism
- Suggestions for improvement

6. Third-Party Review Platforms

We recognise the importance of independent review platforms in helping traders make informed decisions.

While we encourage genuine customer feedback across recognised review platforms, Audacity Capital does not control their moderation policies, verification processes, or operational decisions.

7. Brand Protection & Impersonation

We actively monitor and report suspected:

- Fake reviews
- Brand impersonation
- Fraudulent websites
- Fake social media profiles
- Misleading review profiles
- Scam communications using our brand identity

8. Reporting Fake Reviews

- The platform where the review appears
- The review URL
- Supporting evidence or screenshots
